Notice: Prohibition on Connecting Non-Potable Water to Residential Plumbing

Hello Residents,

This letter serves as an important reminder regarding the use of the non-potable water system within our community.

Under no circumstances should your non-potable water irrigation system be connected to your home's potable (drinking) water plumbing system. Cross-connections between non-potable and potable water systems are prohibited by law and create a serious public health and safety hazard.

Non-potable water is not treated or tested for human consumption and is intended for approved outdoor uses only, such as how it is used in THMD for landscape irrigation.

Connecting your non-potable water irrigation system to your home's drinking water system can contaminate the community potable water supply, potentially putting your household and neighbors at risk

Any unauthorized connection between the non-potable and potable water systems is a violation of applicable plumbing and public health regulations.

If you have made this connection please disconnect any connections you have made immediately.

If you know of any neighbors doing this please let them know about this letter.

This is a serious matter and anyone doing this could be subject to additional enforcement actions, inspections, fines, or other penalties as allowed by law and community regulations.
